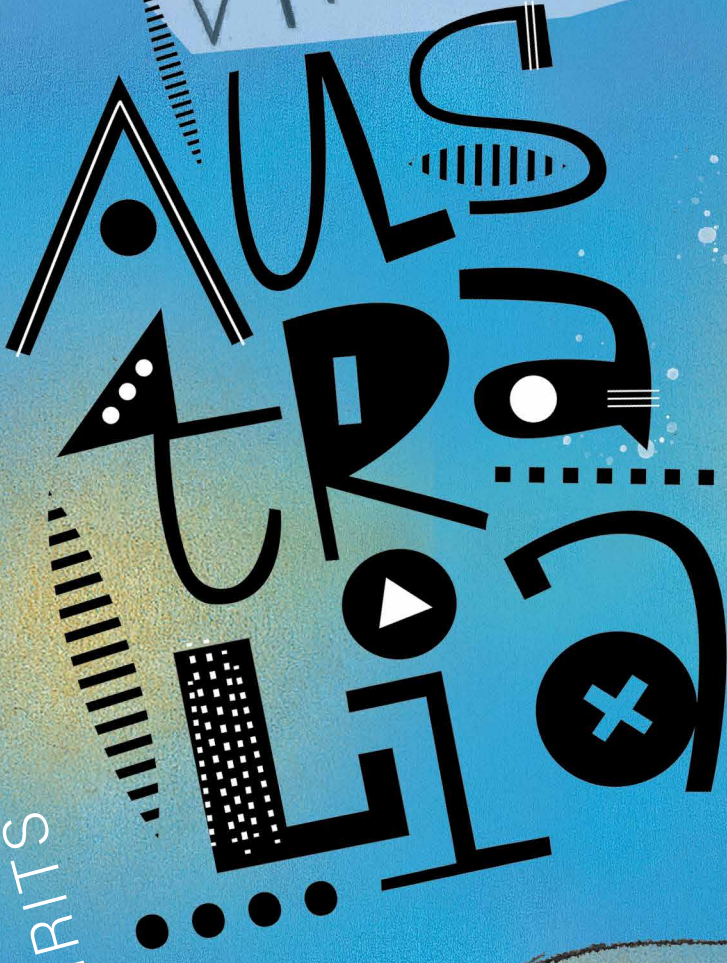


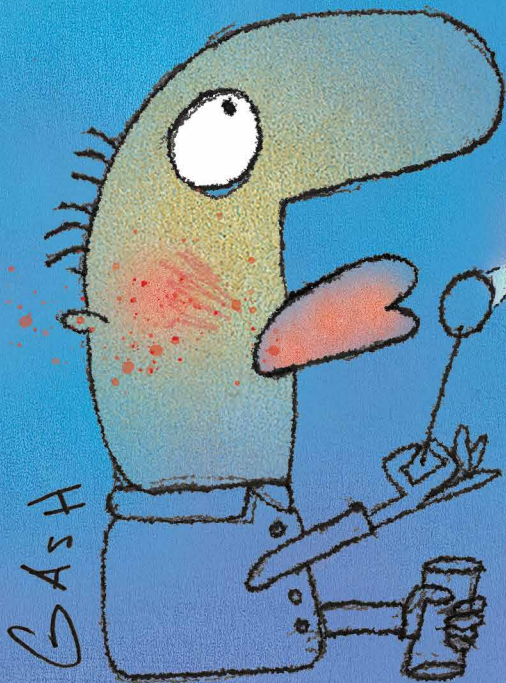

The changing face of Australian wine

As we shine the spotlight on the intriguing offerings that fall under the banner of Australian wine, you may be thinking: *big, ripe and juicy*. Think again. We lift the lid on a diversity of new styles and producers with some of the exciting wines that are reshaping the Australian industry.

There was a time when big, ripe and juicy wines were right on trend, particularly when held up against the famous 'European restraint'. While the big styles still exist – and they do have their place – these days the market for the unashamedly ample is more fickle, becoming for many producers unprofitable and leading to the demise of some big names.

The newly refreshed look we are starting to see is one where the wines display a greater degree of subtlety and nuance, better evoke the intricacies of their particular terroir and successfully champion some of Australia's more unique regions. This change is across the board, with many of the larger, well-established producers right at the vanguard. The family-owned wineries of De Bortoli in the Yarra Valley and Yalumba in the Barossa are just two examples of the latter, both displaying a satisfying degree of fearlessness when it comes to innovation and change.

The advent of these emerging styles is being driven by a new generation of younger Australian wine drinkers. Chardonnay proves to be not as popular in that camp, with the more aromatic styles such as Pinot Grigio, Fiano and Moscato taking precedence. With reds, it's the likes of Tempranillo and Zinfandel that are favoured.

This month you can come in and give these new Australian wines a go; they're unequivocally interesting, delicious and begging to be tried. We'll be opening a good number of them at our Victoria Park and Thorndon stores for a Saturday walk-around tasting; you can book online and come and join us. During August, all of our stores will have a selection of Aussie wines open for tasting, with details on our tasting page.

Grant Burge

This iconic Australian brand delivers

Fifth generation Grant Burge was the one who took the Burge family name to the wine world, forming the eponymous company with his wife Helen in 1988. His great-great grandfather John Burge immigrated to the Barossa in 1855 from Hillcot in England, so Grant's roots ran deep in the famous wine region, lauded for its vivid varietal flavours. Basing their approach on the belief that the terroir of the hallowed Barossa be given room to speak freely via minimal intervention and careful vineyard management, Grant Burge Wines rapidly became a respected and innovative force in the Australian wine industry.

One of the largest landowners in the region, the company excels at well made, value for money wines that are rich with flavour and eminently drinkable. And if more confirmation were needed, Grant Burge Wines has been rated a 5-Red Star Winery for 11 years in a row by the James Halliday Australian Wine Companion.

We're talking Tempranillo and Grenache, both of which call Spain home. Hence Grenache loves the Australian warmth, requiring enough heat to get ripe, but not so much that it's jammy. Low in acidity, retaining the little it has is key. Australia has magnificent old-vine Grenache, crafted with quality in mind, picked earlier and with a lower alcohol content, so it's one to go back to. Tempranillo, the rich, dark and spicy variety behind Rioja's high altitude sub-regions, is also right at home in Australia. The blends of Grenache, Shiraz and Mataro are reminiscent of France's Côtes du Rhône styles.

Mont-Redon's new acquisition comes with kudos

The Abeille-Fabre families are owners of Châteauneuf-du-Pape's famed Mont-Redon winery. With Domaine de l'Oratoire Saint-Martin considered the best site in the appellation of Cairanne, Pierre Fabre's excitement at recently acquiring it cannot be overstated. The appellation itself was recently elevated to Cru status. The Domaine has been farmed organically since the 1990s and biodynamically since the 2000s. Under former owners the Alary brothers, winemaking was very low intervention. Read 'natural'. This is a philosophy that Pierre is excited to continue and explore.

'Possibly the best domaine in the entire Côtes du Rhône-Villages area. The wines are full, intense and concentrated, surprisingly sophisticated. At less than half the price of a top Châteauneuf this domaine offers splendid value for money.' Clive Coates

The unfortified wines beyond port's dark cloak

Portuguese wine has long played second fiddle to the country's ports. However, the quality and exceptional value they deliver has the world paying attention. Joining the EU in 1986 was a significant turning point, with the quality revolution hitting its straps in the late 1990s. A flood of new investment from both local and foreign sources has changed the face of the Portuguese industry. The varieties are indigenous; the reds tend to be bold, with dark hues and intense fruit characters. They are tannic, with good acidity, and can be long-lived. The whites are generous, rich and full of character. Handy terms; *tinto* = red; *branco* = white. The Douro, with its diversity of microclimates, is the most important region for wine production. There, the steep hillside vineyards can vary from 150 to more than 750 metres above the river.

We're Virtually in Tuscany

Sangiovese Central: Art. Food. Wine

While you can't exactly travel at the moment, you could always purchase a selection of these delicious wines, gather a group of friends together, prepare a wonderful pasta (or even just order in some pizza) and take yourselves to Tuscany. Epicentre of the Renaissance and the flashpoint for so much cultural and artistic brilliance, it overflows with names to light up the imagination. Along with Piedmont, Tuscany has the highest percentage of top-tier DOCG wines in Italy, and is home to the scarlet giants Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. The region's premier variety is Sangiovese, which used to make the ubiquitous Chianti, with the variety's greatest expression derived from the legendary *Brunello* clone developed by Montalcino's Biondi-Santi family.

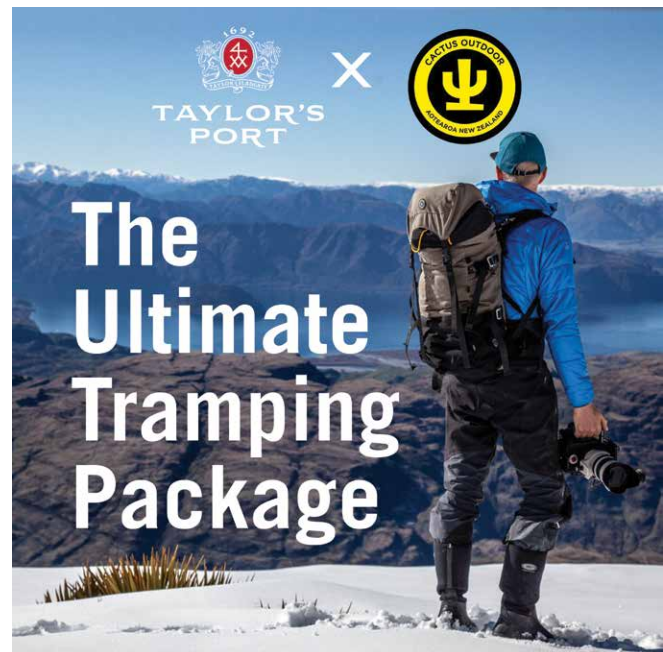

Benoit Tarlant stated, 'Zero dosage is a trend for the others. For us, it is how we started; we've been doing it longer than anyone else.' So what is Zero dosage? After a champagne has aged in the cellars, the sediment (dead yeast cells, or lees) that settle in the bottle are expelled. To do this, the bottle is opened. Before the final closure is put on, a 'liquor' or mix of sugar and wine is added to give the wine its final sweetness level. This is known as the *dosage*. Zero dosage wines are made without the addition of any dosage; they are in fact bone-dry.

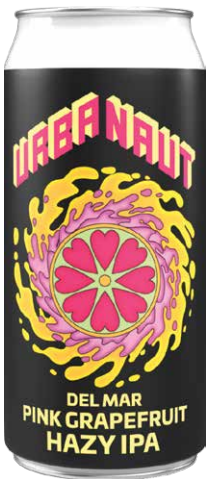
